How to Register

- Go to www.nhrpd.org/register
- Click the "Sign In/Up" button.
 - First Time Users - Click the "Join" button.
 - Returning Users - Enter your log-in information.
- After logging in, click the "Activities" tab near the top of the page and browse our selection of program and events.

We strongly recommend using a desktop or laptop for online registration. Registration may be difficult using mobile devices. Registration for most events and programs are closed 1 week prior to the event/program date.

Processing fees will be applied for all transactions.

Refund Policy

All refund requests must be made either by a written letter that is turned in at the North Highlands District Office or by email to Recreation@nhrpd.org.

Refund requests for events or programs must be submitted 7 days or more prior to the first event or program date to qualify for a refund. The full refund policy can be found on our website.

PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Would you like to participate in a program at North Highlands Recreation and Park District but can only cover part of the cost? Apply for our scholarship!

Eligibility

- Live within District boundaries or within the 95660 zip code
 - Attach documents to the application
- Scholarships are available for:
 - Youth (17 years or younger)
 - Seniors (55 years and older)
- Scholarships cover 50% of any program cost up to \$150.00 per participant per fiscal year.

How to Apply

- Complete the scholarship application and provide proof of residency.
- Submit the application and attached documents in person to our district office at least 10 business days prior to the program start date.

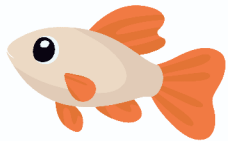

GUPPY - WATER INTRODUCTION Ages 4 - 6 or 7 - 12 No Swimming Experience Needed



The Guppy level is designed to help swimmers build comfort and confidence in the water while learning foundational safety and movement skills with instructor support. Participants are introduced to basic floating, kicking, and water entry techniques in a safe, encouraging environment. With hands-on guidance, swimmers begin developing body awareness and trust in the water while preparing for more independent swimming skills. Recommended for swimmers new to lessons or uncomfortable putting their face in the water.

OTTER - BEGINNER INDEPENDENT Ages 4 - 6, 7 - 12, or 13 - 17 Comfortable in Water, beginning independent movement.

The Otter level builds on foundational water skills by introducing greater independence and coordination in the water. Swimmers begin combining arm and leg movements while practicing breath control and body positioning. This level focuses on developing basic swimming endurance, confidence without instructor assistance, and safe water entry skills.



TURTLE - STROKE DEVELOPMENT Ages 7 - 12 or 13 - 17



The Turtle level focuses on refining swimming skills while introducing coordinated stroke techniques and stronger body control in the water. Swimmers build endurance, practice rhythmic movement, and learn transitions between front and back positions. This level encourages increased independence and prepares participants for more advanced stroke mechanics.

DOLPHIN - STROKE & ENDURANCE Ages 7 - 12 or 13 - 17

The Dolphin level emphasizes stronger stroke coordination, breathing techniques, and increased swimming endurance. Swimmers refine freestyle and backstroke skills while being introduced to more advanced movements that build efficiency and power in the water. This level also focuses on water safety through sustained movement and self-support skills.

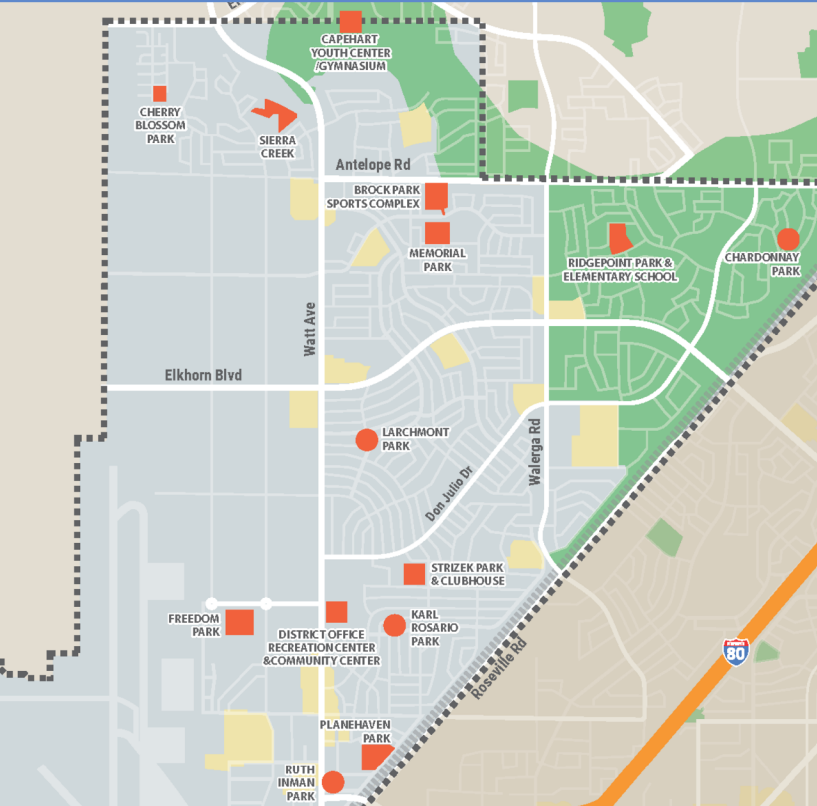
